The Light of Christ and Parvuli Dei are medals are currently \$10 each. If possible, please submit the order from a Cub Unit together to Deacon Klappholz. Please keep a copy of the completed and signed application for both the Cub and the Cub unit.

The knot showing the medal has been earned which is sewn on the uniform above the left shirt pocket may not be obtained until **after** the medal is received. The knot is available for purchase at the Scout Shop.
