

SWIMMING POOL USE AGREEMENT

This agreement is for parties that rent or use the swimming pool at Camp Ingawanis or at the Winnebago Scout Reservation other than during Cub Scout Day Camp, Cub Scout/Webelos Resident Camp or Boy Scout Resident Camp.

The Winnebago Council owns and operates a swimming pool at Camp Ingawanis and at the Winnebago Scout Reservation. These pools are licensed with the State of Iowa through the Iowa Department of Public Health. The Camp Ranger at either camp is a currently trained Certified Pool Operator and is responsible for the pool. Groups renting the pool must meet and agree to the following:

1. The Camp Ranger meets with the lifeguard from the group at least one week in advance and reviews pool rules and operations. These Include:
 - a. Shower house rules
 - b. Pool rules
 - c. Emergency equipment
 - d. Bad weather rules, etc.
2. At least one week prior to the activity, the lifeguard(s) turn in a copy of their current certification of the following to the Camp Ranger:
 - a. American Red Cross Basic Waterl Rescue or BSA Lifeguard
 - b. American Red Cross CPR that includes infant, child and adult
 - c. American Red Cross Standard First Aid
3. The lifeguard in charge is at least 21 years of age. Additional lifeguards are at least 16 years of age. Lifeguards guard from lookout chairs and by standing on the deck.
4. There shall be one lifeguard guarding the pool at all times for up to thirty swimmers in the water and for thirty-one to sixty wswimmers, at least two lifeguards. Three lifeguards are needed sixty-one to ninety swimmers.
5. Swimmers are given a short swim test as determined by the lifeguard on duty to determine if they can go into deep water.
6. Swimmers are paired up and use the "buddy system" when in the water. Each buddy lifeguards his/her buddy.
7. If the lifeguard in charge is not following the pool rules as established by the Camp Ranger, the Camp Ranger will close the pool.
8. The cost to rent the pool is \$150.00/BSA member & \$200.00/non-member per day for actural usage and for any days the pool has been left open prior to that activity. The pool is normally shut down two days following the last day of camp.
9. If the camp provides the lifeguards it will be at an additional charge at a cost needed to recruit these individuals.
