THE UNIT/ORGANIZATION AGREES THAT:

- 1.) Reservations are accepted on a first come, first served, paid in full basis.
- 2.) If your unit, group, or organization cancels a reservation, the fees are not refundable but are transferable to another scheduled ride. If cancelled seven days or less prior to the date of your ride, a 50 % penalty will be assessed. If your group is more than 15 minutes late, the ride is cancelled and there will be no refund.
- 3.) At least two adults must accompany all youth groups and be in attendance **at all times during their stay**. One adult must be at least 21 years of age and one must be at least 18 years of age.
- 4.) Health and accident insurance is a unit, organization, individual and parental responsibility . It is NOT provided by the Wapsi Wranglers as part of the trail ride fee.
- 5.) An informed consent "Waiver Of Liability" form must be completed and turned in to the Wranglers at the time of the ride for ALL groups other than Boy Scouts of America groups that have not supplied the Winnebago Council with an approved "Certificate of Liability Insurance."
- 6.) Trail Ride participants **must be at least 11 years old AND weigh at least 95 pounds**. All riders must be able to mount and dismount the horse under their own power without use of assistive devices. Those who do not meet these criteria will be limited to riding in the arena under the directions of a Wrangler. An adult from your group must lead each horse in arena rides. Only one rider per horse.
- 7.) The Wranglers on site will make all horse assignments, based on the rider's size and ability. They are in charge at all times. Decisions of the Wranglers are final.
- 8.) The adults accompanying youth groups are to maintain control of the group and administer discipline.
