Short Term Reservation Practices

The Unit/Organization agrees to the following:

<p>1. Reservations are made through the Winnebago Council Service Center using the Short Term Reservation Form.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. Priority is given to Council Functions B. Accepted on a first come basis C. Reservations must be in writing D. Reservations must be pre-paid 	<p>2. Cancellations– All fees are non-refundable but are transferable to another date, as follows:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> A. 100% of fees are transferable if cancellation is received 15 days prior to activity B. 50% of fees are transferable if cancellation is received 14 days prior to activity C. No fees are transferable for NO SHOWS
<p>3. Leadership– At least two adults must accompany all youth groups and be in attendance at all times. BSA groups are required to have one adult who is of 21 years and the other of the age of 18. For Scouting groups, one adult must also be registered with the BSA.</p>	<p>4. Health and Accident Insurance– Health and accident insurance is an individual and parental responsibility. Secondary insurance at Ingawanis Adventure Base is provided by the Winnebago Council.</p>
<p>5. Liability Insurance & Hold Harmless Agreements– Non-BSA groups must provide a certificate of liability insurance with the policy limits of at least one million dollars naming the Winnebago Council and the Boy Scouts of America as co-insured. Non-Scout youth groups must also sign an organizational hold harmless agreement.</p>	<p>6. Restrictive Activities– No alcohol, illegal drugs, firearms, or fireworks are allowed on Scout property. Groups in Violation will be asked to leave, forfeiting their fees.</p>
<p>7. Motorized Vehicles– All motorized vehicles must remain on designated camp roads and are subject to other restrictions due to season and activity. No riding in truck beds or trailers.</p>	<p>8. Damages and Clean Up– The rental group is responsible for all damages and clean up charges. Charges incurred will be at replacement cost plus labor at \$25/hour.</p>
<p>9. Check In/Check Out– All units must check in and out with the Camp Ranger. Check out is completed at the location of the reservation. Check in before 8:30 p.m. on Fridays. Check out by noon of last day of reservation.</p>	<p>10. Tour Permit– Scouting groups must file for a tour permit with the Council Service Center at least 7 days before traveling.</p>
<p>11. Canoe/Kayak Rental– Canoe/Kayak rentals for Scouters are \$7.00 and non-scout members are \$20.00, unless prearranged with the Winnebago Council. Safety Afloat and Safe Swim Defense Plans must be used. Please ask the Council Service Center for brochures. Personal floatation devices must be worn while on the water. Renter is responsible for any damages. Rentals are only permitted for travel within 100 miles of Ingawanis Adventure Base.</p>	<p>12. Rifle/Shotgun/Archery– Reservations for using the gun range must be made at least two weeks prior to event. Firearms will not be used outside of the firing range. Groups using the firearm range must supply their own ammunition and follow the National BSA policy for using fire arms. A certified National Rifle Association Firearms Instructor, BSA Certified Range Instructor, Military or Police Range Certified person must be present and have proof of current certification. Groups using a Winnebago Council BSA Certified Range Instructor may only use Winnebago Council firearms. Groups using outside certified range instructors may bring personal firearms on Ingawanis Adventure Base property. Horseplay will not be tolerated. No exceptions.</p>
<p>13. Smoking & Tobacco Products– All buildings and facilities under the Winnebago Council are designated as non-smoking. Smoking outside entrance/exit doors is not permitted at any location and will not be permitted within 100 feet of the participants of any Scouting function.</p>	<p>14. GPS Units– GPS units require a \$100 deposit before they are issued. Cash, check, or unit account are acceptable forms of payment</p>
