

Dear Scoutmaster

Enclosed you will find information regarding the upcoming Merit Badge College, hosted by Lakeland District, to be held at the United Methodist Church and Zion Lutheran Church in Clear Lake on Saturday, March 6, 2010 from 9:00 - 4:00. Registration is 8:15 - 8:45 am at the United Methodist Church, 508 Second Avenue N. The cost is \$10.00 for a full day class and \$5.00 for each half-day class. Lunch, which is included in the cost, will be at the United Methodist Church.

The doors will open at 8:15 am for registration – NOT BEFORE. Anyone coming earlier, please wait outside the building.

Prerequisites are listed and it is **STRONGLY RECOMMENDED** that the scouts complete these before the class. If the prerequisites are not completed prior to class, the scout will NOT receive a complete on the badge. It will be up to the scout to finish the merit badge and work with a merit badge counselor on his own. Please remind the boys to bring a blue merit badge card signed by the Scoutmaster. Tell your scout to bring their merit badge book, paper and pen.

Please return the registration form, with payment, no later than February 12, 2010 to the Mason City Satellite Office @ 1631 4th St. SW, Suite 128A, Mason City, IA 50401. **Deadline for sign-up is February 12, 2010.** A unit leader or parent **MUST** check in all scouts from your unit - not each individual scout, as it is too chaotic at the registration tables. Class sizes are limited therefore we cannot guarantee that each scout will get his first choice – so register early. **To reserve a spot you need to pay in full at the time you send in your registration or you will not be enter in the class without payment.**

Scoutmasters will be notified as to which class the boys are placed in – please make sure that a contact person and phone number listed on the registration so that we are able to do this.

Lakeland District Training Chair, Carol Meyer, will be offering Scoutmaster training all day. In the afternoon (1:00 – 4:00) Troop Committee training classes for your committee members and committee chairs will also be offered. This is a great opportunity to get your leaders trained! Please encourage your adult leaders and committee members to attend!
