

Attendance and participation of Non-Task Force Individuals

1. The New Visions Task Force seeks to be transparent and open to the Scouting community. Task force members appreciate input from the scouting community.
2. Task Force agendas will include 10 minutes at the beginning and 10 minutes at the end of each task force meeting for input from the **general public**.
3. Individuals from the **general public** may speak for up to 2 minutes at either the opening or closing comment section of task force meetings but not both.
4. Non-task force individuals may observe the task force meetings, seated in the gallery (as the meeting room space allows). Visitors will not have the right to speak during the task force deliberations and activities unless a task force member requests that an individual in the gallery speak to the task force and the task force members agree to hear from the non-task force individual.
5. The **Task Force Chairperson** may invite specific individuals with unique expertise and or background to participate in a task force meeting when discussing specific issues.
6. Written communications must include a signature, the individual's name and address or the written communication will NOT be shared. Written communications to the task force will be shared with the task force members at the next meeting or circulated prior to the meeting.
