**RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CLIENT FOR RIDES:**

- The parent or guardian is responsible for all choices of food, party favors, etc.
- Arena rides (for under 11 year olds) are to have an adult to lead each rider/horse and possibly have an additional adult to walk alongside of the horse for very young riders.
- Fill out and turn in **prepaid reservations** minimum of five **days before the event.**
- **Be on time: we reserve the right to cancel if more than 15 minutes late for event.**

**RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE WRANGLERS-**

- We contact the Client upon the receipt of the reservation. We maintain contact if weather conditions are poor. (Safety of horse and riders are our priority). We will assist in setting another "rain date". Weather conditions dictate whether we will be able to ride.

We provide a minimum of two Wrangler volunteers to bring up the horses, groom, tack up the horses, and supervise the event. We arrive two hours before the event to prep the horses.
