- Length of Webelos program
- Does not follow the pattern of other ranks

Updated Code of the Wolf Requirements

2. Build and play a game that requires the use of codes or patterns.
3. Select a single shape. Observe the environment around you. Write down where you see that shape and how it is being used.
4. Using a package that contains a number of different colored items, discover the most common color.

Required Adventure Survey Data

- The survey was conducted by the Research Department of the BSA in collaboration with the National Director and Volunteer Chair of Cub Scouting.
- The survey was sent to all registered Den Leaders as an independent survey on May 25, 2021. Reminders to those who had not responded to the survey were sent on June 3. The survey closed on June 10.
- No Den Leader received the same survey. No Den Leader could comment on more than one required adventure. Den Leaders could comment on multiple ranks for one of the required adventures.

Required Adventures Survey Data

- Bobcat – 6,606 den leaders sent survey with 681 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 10.3%
- Safety – 6,649 den leaders sent a survey with 627 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 9.4%
- Citizenship – 6,525 den leaders sent a survey with 652 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 10%
- Personal Fitness – 6,843 den leaders sent a survey with 668 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 9.8%
- Outdoor – 6,677 den leaders sent a survey with 508 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 7.6%
- Reverence – 6,663 den leaders sent a survey with 744 completing the survey resulting in a response rate of 11.2%

Bobcat Required Adventure Requirements

BEAR – 3RD GRADE

1. Get to know members of your den.
2. Recite the Scout Oath and Scout Law with your den and den leader.
3. Learn about the Scout Oath. Identify the three points of the Scout Oath.
4. With your den Create a Den Code of Conduct.
5. Learn about the denner position and responsibilities.
6. Demonstrate the Cub Scout sign, Cub Scout salute and Cub Scout handshake. Show how each are used.
7. Share with your den, or family, a time when you demonstrated the Cub Scout motto “Do Your Best.” Explain why it is important to do your best.
8. At home, with your parent or legal guardian do the activities in the booklet “How to Protect Your Children from Child Abuse: A Parent’s Guide.”

ARROW OF LIGHT – 5TH GRADE

2. Choose a Patrol name and elect a patrol leader.
